STREET COMMUNITY SCHOOL, WE:	 Respect each others' personal space, belongings and differences. Are courteous and polite in our words and actions. Treat others the way we want to be treated. Respect the authority of Peer Mediators and School Staff. 	 Are positive role models in all areas of the school. Are helpful, kind and do our best. Follow the rules of the school. Use appropriate language. 	 Have positive interactions with others. Seek guidance from Peer Mediators and adults. We listen and follow instructions from all School Staff to help us, especially in emergency situations.
IN THE ENTRY/EXIT,	 Use a quiet calm body and voice. Hold doors open for the next person and wait our turn. 	 Are cautious. Use the correct doors assigned and stay outside until the bell rings. Are prepared to be outside by using the bathroom, having our snacks and being dressed for the weather when we go outside. 	 Keep doorways clear and stay to the right. Use our hands to open and close doors carefully and we watch out for others.
IN THE HALLWAY AND ON THE STAIRS,	 Are respectful of other students' learning by being quiet with our mouths and feet. Are mindful of other people and their property. Are considerate. 	 Stay on the right hand side. Throw litter in the appropriate containers. Walk in single file when we are with our class. 	 Always walk. Are aware of our space. Keep hallways clear. Eat lunch in our classrooms and never in the hallway.
IN THE WASHROOMS,	 Respect others' privacy. Knock before entering a stall. Use the toilets and urinals correctly and flush completely. Leave the room clean. Are quiet. 	 Wash our hands carefully with soap and water. Return to our classroom quickly when we are finished. Report any accidents or messes to the office. 	 Use stalls appropriately, with only one person in each stall. Keep our feet on the floor and never climb or crawl. Keep the floor dry.
IN THE ASSEMBLY,	 Sit respectfully with our hands and feet to ourselves. Stand up quietly before singing our National Anthem. Listen to speakers, teachers and performers. Use the gym washroom quietly and respectfully. 	 Clap, cheer, and laugh at appropriate times. Are quiet and behave between speakers and presentations. Are helpful when we are able. 	 Walk slowly and safely. Keep our hands and feet to ourselves. Remember to leave all aisles clear. Follow instructions.
ON THE PLAYGROUND,	 Use appropriate words to solve our problems. Play cooperatively and fairly. Enjoy the plants and trees with our eyes only. 	 Include others, use kindness and be a buddy to someone who is alone. Use the lower floor washrooms at recess and lunch. Put garbage in garbage cans and bring recycling into school when we return to class. 	 Take turns on equipment and use it safely. Play with rocks, sticks, woodchips and chestnuts safely and never throw them. Stay in safe playground areas.
