#### **Our History**

Eastside Opportunities Society is a nonprofit society established in the 2nd Street School community for the purpose of identifying community needs and responding to them. In 1995, school age care and a youth drop in was identified as a need in the area; and steps to implement a program were followed. The Board of Directors include parents and community residents

The programs opened in the fall of 1996. Kid's Link School Age Child Care Centre is a licensed, group child care facility that now provides licensed, group child care for 45 children from 5-12 years of age, in two facilities. The Eastside Youth Drop-in program now runs Monday to Thursday at 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Community school and Armstrong Elementary School. Over the years we have continued to identify what the community and schools needs and have implemented programs like the Breakfast and Homework Program, Lunch Programs and Friday Night at the Dive-In.
