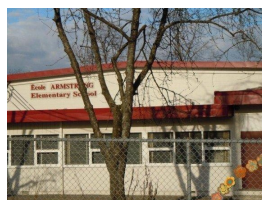


Our History

Eastside Opportunities Society is a Not-for-Profit Society established in the 2nd Street School community for the purpose of identifying community needs and responding to them. In 1995, school age care and a youth drop in was identified as a need in the area; and steps to implement a program were followed. The Board of Directors include parents and community residents

The programs opened in the fall of 1996. Kid's Link School Age Child Care Centre is a licensed, group child care facility that now provides licensed, group child care for 63 children from 5-12 years of age, in three spaces. The Eastside Youth Drop-in program now runs Monday to Thursday at 2nd Street Community school and Armstrong Elementary School. Over the years we have continued to identify what the community and schools needs and have implemented programs like the Breakfast and Homework Program, Lunch Programs and Friday Night at the Dive-In.

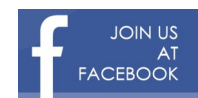
It offers school age child care, preteen programs, girls groups, youth programs and supports needs in our community.

 9 am-3 pm. Camp subsidies are available.



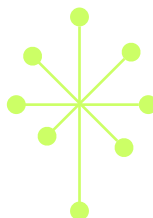
What we do at Summer Fun:

Before and After	\$355/month
Before Only	\$205/month
After Only	\$305/month
Kindergarten	\$255/month
Winter/Spring Break (enrolled children only)	\$30/day extra
Drop In (non enrolled children)	\$45/day
Professional Day	Included in monthly fee
Summer (July/August)	\$650/month \$175/week
