## 2. Update from our Community Coordinator (Patricia)

- Knitting club is underway great to see 20 ELL students joined for the first session. Thanks again to volunteer, Gloria for making it a great experience for them and teaching knitting!
- Holiday Hampers this year they will include only gift cards to support families, however some donors will continue to make up hampers and coordinate delivery to some of our families. An email went out – you can donate through cash online or directly to the community office (cash or gift cards) if you are interested in supporting this important initiative.
- Breakfast with Santa this event will not be going ahead. See Patricia's email for the rationale. The school-wide pancake breakfast (Dec. 20) will be done and will include an invitation to our community.

- Tea Time with Rob Smith postponed. Will take place Nov 27 @ 9-10:30
- Guru Nanak feast Nov 29 9:15-12. All students, staff and community are invited to the gym to partake in a traditional Indian feast. Thanks to the families who are donating the supplies and their time to coordinate this celebration. ACTION: come and join in and if you can help with clean up, that would be great.
- Donations to Christmas Bureau Cariboo Hill Secondary will be doing a Toy Drive in December.
- If anyone has time, there are several letters prepared that need to be delivered to several
  potential sponsors for school-wide needs (including hampers). ACTION: reach out to Patricia if
  you can help deliver some letters this week.
- 3. Update from our Principal (Bryan)
  - Fireworks it was a great event and thank you to everyone who came to volunteer.
  - Emergency Procedures we've spent the month going over all the emergency procedures and running drills. Request for feedback about how it went.
  - Vacancies replacements have been hired for both Ms. Kruschner and Mr. Kevin Herd. The new staff will be starting on December 2<sup>nd</sup>.

- 4. CPAC Budget Review & Approval (Anne)
  - CPAC Executive Recommended Budget was presented and discussed.
    - Contribution to Field Trips to align with current cost of a school bus shared by two classes (~\$600)
    - Contribution to Classroom Consumables always spent and well received by teachers who
      often pay out of pocket to support the classroom in fun ways (stickers, furniture, craft supplies)
    - Contribution of \$150 to Pancake Breakfast will only fund the purchase of pancake mix and syrup – no extras. Discussion to consider supporting this event more like we support other community events. In the end, Larry Hayes stepped up with a generous personal donation to support the full cost of the school-wide pancake breakfast. Thank you, Larry.
    - Reviewed all suggested changes from last year's budget.
    - Reviewed all unsupported items outlined on the 'Fundraising Story' handout. ACTION: let people in your community know what we are not able to support and consider creative ways to meet these needs.
    - Several grants are being applied for to support some of these unmet asks: iPads for LSS, Sensory Hallway Decals, Conference Room Technology, Document Cameras/Projectors, Music Equipment and Podcast Cart. As these grant cycles vary in timing, we are not clear what needs will remain unmet. As such, the \$1477 that remains unallocated from this year will be held to go towards the technology purchases at the school next year.
    - Budget as presented motioned by Gloria, seconded by Charisse. No objections. Passed.
    - ACTION: Anne to work with treasurer to allocate funds and email final budget to school administration.
